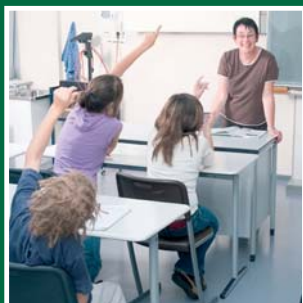

The students are brought to the Academy by their Host Family for lessons to commence at 09:00, there is a break at 11:00 and then further lessons until 12:00. A hot two course lunch is then served at the Academy before afternoon activities commence. Tea is provided and then the students are collected by their Host Family for homework, supper and further activities.

Host Families

English as a foreign language



COURSES in English as a foreign language take place from April to September.

If necessary extra tuition in specific subjects can be provided.

All lessons take place in Hollingrove Academy with specialist tutors who are experts in their subjects.

Students are divided into small classes, dependant on age and ability.

Boarding School

Your Location

The Old Parish Mill is a beautiful 17th Century converted watermill, now the home of Lord Andrew and Lady Elizabeth Hollingrove.

THE mill is situated within seven acres of garden which is a haven for wildlife.....kingfishers, buzzards, pheasant, ducks, Muntjac deer and squirrels. It is also conveniently located for The Royal Forest of Dean and The Cotswolds.

ROYAL FOREST OF DEAN

The Royal Forest of Dean is a place of Outstanding Natural Beauty, one of England's few remaining ancient forests covering over 11,000 hectares of woodland.

GLOUCESTER

The focal point for this Historic City is Gloucester Cathedral. This Gothic masterpiece has been brought to worldwide attention due to the success

of the Harry Potter films. The Cathedral was an ideal setting for Hogwarts.

CHELTENHAM

Cheltenham Spa is full of Regency splendour; from the Regency Cotswold Stone architecture to its award winning gardens there is something for everyone in the heart of the Cotswolds.

BOURTON-ON-THE-WATER

Bourton-on-the-Water is famous for its traditional Cotswold architecture, some dating back to the seventeenth century. With wonderful honey coloured limestone walls.

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

Stratford-upon-Avon is

famous above all else as the birthplace of William Shakespeare. Attractions include the Royal Shakespeare Theatre, Shakespeare's Birthplace, Nash's House, Anne Hathaway's Cottage and Mary Arden's House..
